



## 2021 COVID POLICIES

For the summer of 2021, Circus Camp will follow all federal and state-level guidelines to the best of our ability. Specifically, we are following the CDC Suggestions 'for Youth Programs and Camps.' The summary of our policies is listed below.

### Camper Safety

- Campers will move through activities in cohorts organized by age group.
- Cohorts will exist of no more than 10 campers and will include the same staff throughout the day.
- Campers are required to maintain social distancing norms (6 feet per state regulation)
- Safety skits educating campers about covid rules will be presented each Monday.
- There will be daily screening on arrival meaning temperature check.
- Masks are mandatory.
- Sanitation of equipment between uses.
- Most activities will have an individual item for the camper and will be sanitized after use.
- Handwashing is mandatory three times a day.
- Sanitizer will be required after each activity.

### Staff

- Annual safety training for staff will include covid related issues.
- Staff will receive daily screening.
- All staff members are required to wear masks.
- Staff members who exhibit covid symptoms, exposure, or fever will be sent home until they are tested, and all appropriate communications will follow.
- Backup staff and cross-training will exist in the event of staff illness.

### Parents

- Open communication will be encouraged.
- Parents are asked to relate any concerns as quickly as possible to camp leaders.
- Drop-off and pickup times will be staggered for safety.
- No parents may enter the facility.
- We will not be hosting our camp shows this year due to safety concerns.

### Facility communication

- Camp administrators will stay in contact with facility operators to make sure we are following their guidelines.
- We are also in communication with them in case a staff member or camper gets sick.
